Dear Parent or Caregiver,

Hunter River High School will continue the Community Volunteer Tutoring Program in 2020. This program allows students in years 7 to 12 to be tutored for one hour each Friday.

Your child has volunteered as one of the students who would appreciate and benefit from having a 1 to 1 or small group session with a community tutor each week. The tutoring time will be used to assist your child with literacy and/or numeracy skills with time available in each session to help with homework and assignments if needed.

The tutoring will take place in the Library and your child will be supervised at all times throughout the period. Your child will be assigned a tutor and will work with the same tutor each week where possible. This will be useful as students will develop a rapport with their tutor and hopefully feel comfortable asking for help. The tutor will have completed training sessions prior to working with your child so will be ready and prepared.

We ask that you discuss this program with your child as we need only committed students to begin the program. Many students in the school require this assistance, but only a limited number of places are available.
