- Be of Aboriginal and /or Torres Strait Islander descent, and to self-identify and be accepted or known by your community.
- If you are under 17 years of age and wish to enroll you will need to have completed Year 10 or have special permission from school and TAFE to do so.

HOW DOES IT WORK

The course is a partnership between TAFE NSW and Nikinpa Aboriginal Child & Family Centre. It will be delivered over two semesters at Nikinpa.

Nikinpa Children's Service provides a culturally appropriate stimulating environment in which children can learn, laugh, play and grow. Like our culture the Nikinpa community is built around relationships.
