


CERTIFICATE II IN HOSPITALITY

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be of Aboriginal and /or Torres Strait Islander descent, and to self-identify and be accepted or known by your community.
- You must be 18 years or older at the time you will be undertaking any units that will require you to handle alcohol.
- If you are still enrolled in school you will need to have completed Year 10 or have special permission from school and TAFE to do so.
