Hunter River High School Works notification | 28 May 2024

A project is underway to upgrade Hunter River High School to bring students the latest educational facilities and support the local community.

Concrete pouring on Friday 31 May 2024

Construction of the new gymnasium building is progressing. As part of this work, ground level concrete pours will take place on Friday 31 May 2024. Should wet weather impact these works, pours will be scheduled for the following week.

What to expect

- Approximately 30 concrete trucks will travel to site to supply concrete.
- Gates will open at the regular time of 6:30 am to enable traffic control to be setup.
- Noise generating works will be restricted to 7 am to 5 pm as per DA approval.
- Pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite site of Adelaide Street during these works.
- Traffic control will be in place to help vehicles and pedestrians safely navigate the area while work is taking place (see map of the traffic management plan overleaf).
- Noise levels are not expected to exceed those generated by regular construction activities.

Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school's students, staff, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. Construction is planned so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures are in place to separate the construction site from areas occupied by the school and ensure students are unable to enter construction areas. There is regular consultation with the school to discuss construction progress.
